Project objective:			
The project objectives are :			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Help the Maghreb Universities to implement HE reforms by exchanging and disseminating the experiences and good practices EU Universities have developed according to the Bologna recommendations. - Contribute through the exchanges of students and University staff to the reinforcement of educational, cultural, scientific and technological links between EU and Maghreb countries. - Foster the co-operations between Maghreb and EU Universities in view of a better 			

knowledge and understanding between people.

- Promote procedures for common recognition of syllabuses and diplomas using ECTS and the Diploma Supplement in order to increase the employability of Maghreb students without encouraging "brain drain" from South to North.
- Develop within the Maghreb Universities the management of student and staff mobilities by implementing adequate awareness, communication and management procedures.

Brief description:

The AVERROES project consortium includes Nine Maghreb Universities : Tunis, Sfax, Sousse, Oran, Bejaïa, Constantine, Rabat, Tetouan and Marrakech and 11 EU Universities : Montpellier (3), Marseille 2, Perpignan, Genoa, Catania, Balearic Islands, SupAgro Montpellier, Cadiz and Liege. The project will be co-ordinated by the University of Montpellier 2 which has a long lasting experience of European projects management. The consortium will also include 17 associates which will be involved in the organisation of the mobilities, in the hosting and welcome of students or in the diffusion of information. The mobility activities will concern all levels and most of the fields mentioned in the call for proposals with a priority given to the fields which are of major interest for Maghreb universities. On the whole, 326 mobilities are foreseen with 254 concerning the South-North direction and 72 the other direction.
